The Participants acknowledge that a wide variety of activities are conducted at Camp Foley and give permission for the above adults and children to participate in these activities assuming all ordinary risks normally inherent to the nature of the activities which include but are not limited to the following: waterskiing, sailing, windsurfing, canoeing, biking, climbing tower, archery, riflery, paintball, group sports and games, fencing, teams course, and woodworking shop. Participants agree to abide by all rules set by Camp Foley especially in regards to personal behavior and safety found on page two of this form and in the Family Camp portion of the website. Participants realize that involvement in the camp program may subject him/her to certain stresses and hazards, which may include but are not limited to sun, lightning, wind, stinging and disease carrying animals (ticks, spiders, insects, etc.), poisonous plants, proper hydration, etc. not all of which can be foreseen. Parents take full responsibility for children while on camp grounds including but not limited to supervision, care, transportation and basic medical services including medication and basic first aid. Enrollment Agreement

“The mission of Camp Foley is to partner with parents to develop confident, responsible and respectful youth who gain skills and have fun through a quality camp experience in a youth centered community.”

Camp Foley invites participants of good character who are eager to immerse themselves into camp life – living in a small community, developing relationships, learning new skills, and being exposed to new experiences.

In addition it is understood that Camp Foley has the right to dismiss any person whose behavior, attitude or action, is in our judgment, contrary to the best interests of our camp community. This includes but is not limited to: raids or pranks causing bodily harm, embarrassment, or destruction of property, excessive fighting, harassment, bullying, cults, or for other conduct that is ruining another participants’ experience or is harmful to camp. It is understood and agreed, by camp and participants, that possession or use of tobacco, alcohol, or controlled substances while enrolled in camp will bring immediate dismissal. Possession of any weapon may also bring immediate dismissal. Camp Foley will, if necessary, search for, confiscate and dispose of any items that violate camp policy or are used in inappropriate ways.

This application and deposit constitutes an enrollment agreement only when accepted by Camp Foley in writing and shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota. Furthermore, State and Federal courts within the State of Minnesota, County of Crow Wing, shall have exclusive jurisdiction to adjudicate any dispute arising out of this enrollment agreement or any subsequent agreement or amendments thereto. We consider your enrollment and/or payment as acknowledgment and acceptance of all the terms of this agreement.

Health & Safety

A resident Registered Nurse is available to meet routine medical needs. Special medical needs are met in nearby clinics, pharmacies and hospitals and are not included in the camp fee. Parents are responsible for all expenses incurred by illness or accident.

Activities

Participants of all ages and abilities can participate in all of the camp activities with the following exceptions: **All-Terrain Biking** – Tall enough to ride a 13” bike safely; **Trap Shooting** – Twelve years old & target shooting experience; **Paintball** - Ten years old and a separate signed waiver by a parent or guardian if under the age of 18 is required.

Financial

The required deposit is due with the application to enroll in the family camp session. Additional payments are due by March 1. By May 1, the total tuition is due. Any unpaid balances are subject to a finance charge of 1.5% per month. You may make payments online on our secure server.

Cancellation or Withdrawals

Prior to March 1, a \$25.00 cancellation fee will be retained per person. From March 1 to May 1, \$50.00 cancellation fee will be retained per person. From May 1 to July 15, \$200.00 will be retained per person. A cancellation within 30 days of the start of the session will forfeit full tuition. No adjustment in tuition is made for late arrival, early departure, or dismissal.

Other Optional Expenditures:

Each family will have an open "Canteen Account" for use while at Foley. At the end of the week you will be asked to pay your account with cash, check or credit card (visa or mastercard)

Canteen (Camp Store): Available items include camp apparel, toiletry articles, film, stamps, stationery, water bottles, fun items, etc.

Waterskiing and Trap Shooting: Your Registration Fee includes 3, 1-hour time slots for these two activities. Additional time may be purchased for an additional fee (subject to availability). Trap shooting requires the purchase of ammunition at the camp store for a small fee.

Transportation

Transportation to and from camp will be the responsibility of the individual family. A parking lot is available for vehicles. Camp Foley assumes no liability for loss or damage to vehicles due to weather, theft, or other unforeseeable issues regarding your personal vehicle.

To Let You Know

Camp Foley assumes no liability for loss or damage to personal property or for injury incurred as a result of use of personal property. Foley discourages all borrowing and lending among anyone living or working in camp. Participants may never use “special personal equipment” owned by others such as: watercraft, skis, musical instruments, aquatic equipment, or other items that are associated with specific risks (health, financial, accidents, etc.). Any money or valuables in your possession upon arrival at camp may be deposited at the office for safe keeping. The camp assumes no responsibility for funds or valuables not so deposited.

Participant permission is assumed for use of any pictures or videos used in camp promotion, on our website, in the memory photo's and for fun mailings throughout the year. Upon request, you or your child can be excluded.

Participants will be held responsible for damage to property and equipment caused by their negligence and will be charged accordingly for repairs or replacement.
